#### MA APCD Intake

- All APCD files through September 2024 were due by October 31<sup>st.</sup> This includes any re-submissions.
- Please work with your liaison in submitting any overdue files.
- Please be mindful when selecting the Submission Month and Year in FileSecure. If the wrong month and/or year is selected, it will deactivate previously submitted, valid files.
- CHIA continues to revisit Medical and Pharmacy Claim versioning methods with select payers. We'll reach out when we have examples to share as we analyze the logic for each company.
- Please alert CHIA if you change PBMs as that could impact pharmacy claims versioning methods.



# **MA APCD 2025 Submission Guide Updates**

- 2025 MA APCD submission guide changes related to CHIA's health equity strategy.
- New filing type: Demographic (DE) file
  - Includes some existing Member Eligibility data elements
  - Additional data elements added
  - Will require a new version of CHIA's FileSecure application

# **Current State: Limited Equity Data in APCD**

- APCD is a rich source of eligibility and claims data from more than 80 payers, including MassHealth and Medicare MCOs
  - Demographic data is collected from members, but data currently submitted to CHIA is very limited: Gender, 5-digit zip code, preferred language (English/Spanish/other)
- CHIA proposes to collect available RELD/SOGI and member address data from payers to enhance reporting
  - Monitor disparities in coverage, access, utilization, cost, quality, and affordability by race/ethnicity, region, and other sociodemographic characteristics using APCD data



# **Payer Data Elements of Interest**

- Align with QMAT data standards to ensure interoperability with other CHIA data assets (including hospital EHR data) and encourage consistency across state agencies
  - Race (QMAT)
  - Ethnicity (QMAT)
    - Hispanic ethnicity
    - Granular ethnicity
  - Preferred Language (QMAT+)
    - Written
    - Spoken

- Sexual orientation (QMAT)
- Gender Identity (QMAT)
- Disability Status (QMAT)
- Address
- Sex assigned at birth

 QMAT Health Equity Data Standards TAG will reconvene in early 2025 to update recommendations, including consideration of the new OMB requirements.

## **Enrollment Trends Update**

- The next Enrollment Trends reporting cycle will be based on data through September 2024 and is scheduled to be published in February 2025.
- CHIA sent out requests for Supplemental data to certain payers, due back to CHIA by November 15th. Reminder:
  - To more accurately reflect payer-submitted Supplemental data in the report, we are now requesting 9 snapshot dates (by quarter) instead of 3 quarterly snapshots. CHIA provided new templates.
  - This change aligns with the way payers' APCD ME data is used and reported upon.
- CHIA will be sending payers MA APCD-sourced enrollment counts for review in early December 2024
  - o If there are any issues with this data we request you contact us as soon as possible, otherwise, by **Friday, December 20th, 2024** at the latest. If we do not hear back from you by that date we will assume there are no issues with your data.

# **DOI** Reporting

- Q3 2024 HMO Membership reports are in process now that Sep-2024 data has been submitted. Expect these reports to be sent later this month.
- O Claims/Utilization reports using data through March 2024 were sent to payers in September. Signoff is due 11/18.
- Claims/Utilization reports using data through September 2024 will be sent to payers in December.
- We continue to meet with some payers to reconcile differences in certain utilization report categories.
