Patient's 5 digit zip code is linked to a geocoding database to determine the zip code's latitude/longitude for mapping purposes. This allows us to plot a patient as a point on a map - but does not provide any additional identification information that could be used to identify the patient.

What databases are involved, who owns the data and which specific data elements will be used for linkage:

The database is provided by SAS Corp. from Cary, NC and is not proprietary information. The terms under which we use SAS software allows us to use this information. The only element used to get geocoding info is the zip code.

Linking facility level information to CMS Cost Reports is done to be able to estimate cost of care.

The CHIA data is linked to CMS Cost Reports as publically released by CMS as the "HCRIS" data. Facility ID and a year are the only data elements used in the linkage.

Facility ID provided by CHIA is manually mapped to CCN, CCN plus date range of the data (CY 2013 for example) is used to find the best match with the Cost Report filed by each CCN.

The linkage does not require patient level info - each patient has the CHIA facility ID and a date range already attached.
